#### **HOW TO SAVE AND BORROW FOR A CAR**

#### DETERMINE HOW MUCH YOU CAN AFFORD.

Talk with your parents or stop by your credit union with your parents to determine how much you can afford. When getting a loan, consider the interest rate of the loan, the term of the loan, and the principal amount. When owning a car, consider monthly cay payments, gas, maintenance and repairs, and fees, such as registration fees.

#### CALCULATE YOUR DOWN PAYMENT.

The larger the down payment, the less money you will need to borrow and pay back overall.

#### **CREATE A SAVINGS PLAN.**

Once you have determined the amount you will need to save, set up a savings plan to help you reach this goal. Make sure the numbers are doable and that you will be able to meet the goal.

#### **AUTOMATE YOUR SAVINGS.**

To make the process simpler, set up an automatic monthly transfer to a specialized savings account. If your goal is long-term, you may want to consider opening a certificate account or similar account instead of a conventional savings account.
